**Feedback On Curriculum-Analysis and Action taken Report-**  
**Summary of Stakeholders' Session -- 2021--22**

**Students :**

1. Feedback on curriculum was on ten points, which was prescribed by I.Q.A.C. These points were regarded to syllabus, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, transparency of evaluation system, co-operation of non-teaching, entrepreneurship, outcomes, quality and infrastructural facilities.

2. With relation to statement, four weighing parameter were laid as very good- good- satisfactory- unsatisfactory; According to statistical and descriptive analysis it stands as 49.75%, 35.75, 12.5, .75 percentage responses availed from the students.

**Teachers :**

1. Feedback on curriculum was taken on eleven points, which were based on course objectives and outcomes, books available in library, infrastructural facility, test examination, freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching such as seminar, presentation, funding and support by management and provisions for professional development.

2. With relation to statement four parameter were laid as very good- good- satisfactory- unsatisfactory. According to statistical and descriptive analysis it stands orderly as 50.75%, 46.96%, 2.27% . - Assistant Professor of 11 subject, out of 09 department submitted feedback.

3. They expressed that syllabus should be in accordance with requirement of employability.

**Alumni :**

1. Syllabus should be based on career orientation and it will be useful in practical skill.

2. Four parameter were laid for weighing. These were analyzed as 39.79%, 48.54%, 12.70%, .41%

3. Rajarshri Shahu Maharaj Employment –Self employment- and Guidance Centre organized guidance classes which became helpful for competitive examination. It provided skill training for self-employment.


4. Through the Home Economics and Music practical, professional based events are applied.
