

**Report of Study Tour organize by Department of Sociology to Matoshri Old Age Home**

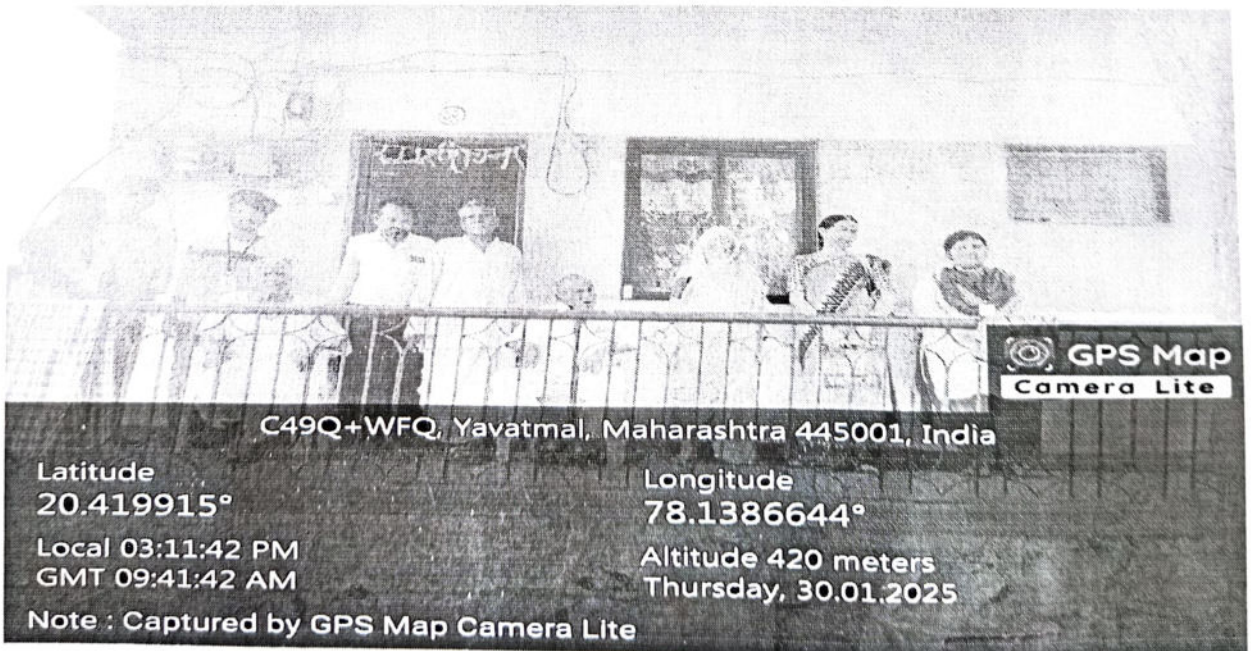
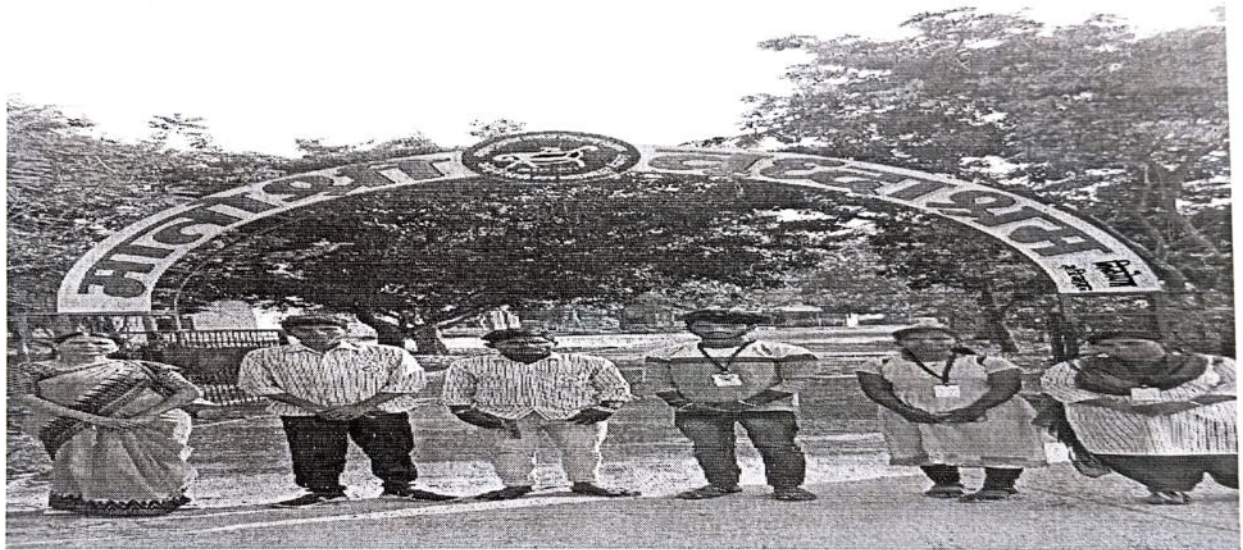
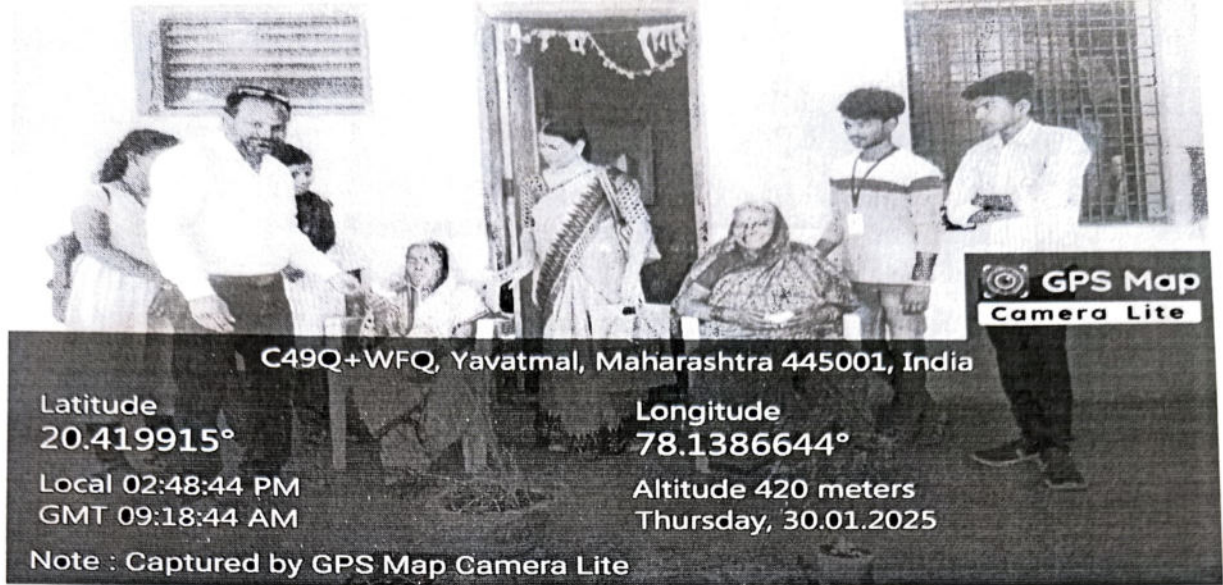

The home, established in 1998 by Sanskrutik Sanvardhan Mandal, provides selfless service to the elderly. On Thursday, January 30, 2025, Prof. Dr. Vishakha Dere and students from Smt. Nanakibai Wadhawani College of Arts distributed essential items to the residents. Thirty-five elderly men and women were present at the home. Old age is an inevitable biological stage, and it is expected that children will take care of their parents during this phase. Traditionally, Indian society considers it the duty of children to care for their aging parents. However, in recent times, many youth are unwilling to fulfil this moral obligation due to financial constraints. The Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act makes it a legal obligation for youth to provide financial support to their parents.

The elderly often face numerous problems, and it is essential to provide them with special care. However, many elderly individuals are neglected, leading to the establishment of old age homes like Matoshri. The home provides selfless service to the elderly.

The students received a positive response from the residents, including Madhav Kale, Bajrang Agrawal, Yamuna Tambakhe, and Pandurang Kikoskar.
