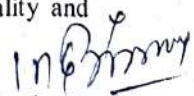
The conference concluded with a formal **Valedictory Function**.

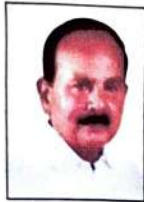
